It is the largest and most intact coastal forest in East Africa, with 20% of Kenya's bird species, 30% butterfly species and at least 24 rare and endemic bird, mammal and butterfly species. It is a precious Coastal rain forest that used to span from Southern Somalia to Northern Mozambique.

## MARAFA (HELL'S KITCHEN)



One of the most underrated sites on the Kenyan coast, named by the natives 'Nyari', 'The place broken by itself', the geological formation was caused by erosion of the sandstone escarpment, revealing a unique set of vibrantly coloured rock layers, from white to pinks, oranges and deep crimsons. Best visited during sunset hours.

## BOARD WALK AROCHA-KENYA

A tidal inlet that expands across an area of 32 km<sup>2</sup> and one of the most productive mangrove ecosystems in the world. Surrounded by extensive mangroves and lined with palms. Healthy beds of seagrass and coral, home to many species of fish and feeding sea turtles, while in the mangroves smaller streams and inlets provide a refuge for crabs and birdlife. It's also a stopover point for many rare migratory birds and an essential protected area for their survival.

## **MNARANI RUINS AND REPTILE PARK**



The white Pillar in the picture is called a 'Mnara' in Swahili. It is what the ruins and the area got their name from. The History of this ruins dates back to the 13<sup>th</sup> Century when Omani Arabs came to the East Coast of Africa for trade. Their businesses flourished and they built their residences at Mnarani; which has two mosques and a tomb. The site is now run by the National Museums of Kenya and you have to walk up 107 stairs to get there.

## **VUMA CLIFFS TAKAUNGU, KILIFI**



Just outside the village of Takaungu in Kilifi, you can hike or drive down dirt roads, past spiky fields of sisal and giant baobabs towering above maize crops. Abruptly, the land ends in jagged black coral cliffs, pounded relentlessly by the rolling waves of the Indian Ocean. It is a desolate and lonely place that seems like a secret portal into Scotland rather than the Kenyan Coast.

During low tide you can scramble down from the path to a naturally formed turret in the rock to better appreciate the crashing waves.
